AS WE GATHER

Signs play a huge role in our culture. We depend on them to help us navigate our roadways. We look to them to find our destinations. We rely on them to direct our way through crowded hallways. They tell us when to stop and when to go. They inform our decisions and determine our path.

In our text for today, Jesus uses a sign to illustrate his glory. He takes the opportunity at a wedding to show that he is much more than what people expect. This miracle of turning water into wine is a sign that Jesus' mission and ministry are much bigger than simply saving a host from offending his guests. Through this sign, Jesus' disciples caught a glimpse of Jesus' unknown purpose...and they believed.
