AS WE GATHER

Have you ever been lost? Have you ever lost something? When something or someone is lost, we can either resign ourselves to the loss or search diligently until what is lost is found. And when the lost is found, what joy is experienced! This is a picture of the loving God who seeks us and finds us. This is the story of people who easily run from God and yet are pursued by the love and mercy of the one who created us. We have all been lost. The good news is that we have all been found. God is relentless in his search of us. God seeks the lost and rejoices when sinners repent. The word "repent" means to turn and face a new direction. No longer lost, the person now faces God. Instead of anger and wrath, the lost person discovers a God who welcomes the lost home and throws a party. No doubt, the lost person rejoices, but this joy pales in comparison to the joy of God who finds the lost.
