AS WE GATHER

I love watching people discover how the things they are good at [gifts] and the things they enjoy [passions] merge together to form a perfect union. I remember working with a group of confirmation students. The excitement they felt as we explored their gifts and tied them to the activities in which they had previously chosen to participate was indescribable. The freedom they experienced as they realized that God had gifted them for a specific purpose in life and the expectation with which they looked forward to putting all the pieces together was truly a joy to witness.

It must have been like that for Peter, James and John that day, for they, without hesitation, "left everything and followed him." Can you imagine the power of that experience?
